About Optomap and Optovue OCT

Because evaluation of the inside of your eyes is an essential part of every comprehensive eye examination, dilation of the pupils is usually necessary. Pupil dilation, however, creates many inconveniences for you, including having to put drops in your eyes, waiting for the drops to take effect (about 30 minutes), then the inability to see clearly for many hours after the exam.

Broadway Vision Source has two technologies available to you that enable our optometric physicians to perform retinal evaluations more thoroughly and efficiently, without the need for pupil dilation in most cases. These technologies are called **Optomap**, and **Optical Coherence Tomography (OCT)**. Each of these is fast, safe, and comfortable. The images that are obtained are stored securely within your personal records, and can also be used for reference or baseline for your future examinations.

We recommend having these evaluations routinely performed for all patients from age 10 years old and up during each comprehensive eye examination.

Because vision insurance does not cover advanced screening procedures such as OCT and Optomap, this is an out-of-pocket expense. The fee for both procedures is \$47.00
